

## **Online Payments Terms and Conditions**

### **Online Payments Terms and Conditions Debit card payments Disclaimer Online Payment.**

Any Applicant who elects to make payments for General Department of Traffic by Debit Card online will be asked by the Online Payment Service Provider to furnish his/her personal information, including card number, expiry date and your Debit card PIN code, etc. Such information will be transmitted electronically and directly to the Online Payment Service Provider (KNET). General Department of Traffic does not warrant the confidentiality or security of such information, whether personal or otherwise, when it is transmitted to the Online Payment Service Provider (although General Department of Traffic will take reasonable steps to maintain confidentiality and security). General Department of Traffic shall under no circumstances be liable for any special, direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage which is suffered, sustained or incurred by the Applicant arising (directly or indirectly) from or out of or relating to payments by debit card online.

### **Payment Authorization**

Subject to this Agreement, you authorize us to hold, receive funds in accordance with your payment instructions. Your authorization permits us to debit or credit your debit card.

### **Unauthorized Payments**

If you believe that someone has made an unauthorized payment through Online Payment without your permission, contact your financial institution immediately. You are solely responsible for any unauthorized payments.

### **Transaction Limits**

We may delay, suspend or reject a transaction for any Applicant for any reason, including without limitation if we suspect the transaction subjects us to financial or security risk or is unauthorized, fraudulent, suspicious, unlawful, in violation of the terms of this Agreement, subject to dispute or Chargeback, or otherwise unusual.

### **Payments Reversal**

Your payment may be reversed to your account if the payment:

- a. is disputed by the issuer bank,
- b. is reversed for any reason by the payment processor, issuer bank, or acquiring bank,
- c. was not authorized or we have any reason to believe that the transaction was not authorized,
- d. is allegedly unlawful, suspicious, or in violation of the terms of this agreement, or
- e. declined or refused for any other reason.

By Agreeing to these terms and conditions you have read and understand the foregoing agreement and agree to be bound by the online payment's terms and conditions for Debit Card Payments. These Terms and conditions are subject to change at any time without notice.
